These laboratories perform thousands of tests weekly for not only VCUHS/MCV patients, but a myriad of State Agencies and Departments, as well as public and private hospitals and outpatient medical facilities. This is a great opportunity for us to support and give back to those on the front lines of battling this pandemic.
