Thalhimer associates donated many flowers and herbs, garden soil, fertilizer, garden hoses, watering cans, and plant markers.
 - Richmond associates performed spring cleaning at Better Housing Coalition's first rental community, Cary West. They painted fences and collected trash around the property.

Providing much-needed supplies

 Thalhimer associates donated various supplies needed for Better Housing Coalition including garden spades and trowels, garden shears, deck boxes for gardening storage, and gift cards to Home Depot.
