## All Roads Lead to the Port

The Port of Virginia is building the most modern gateway in America and is making record-setting investments to create a premier logistics ecosystem. Terminal and crane expansion projects are well underway along with channel dredging that will accommodate unprecedented two-way traffic for the world's ultra large container ships. Virginia will boast a 5.8 million TEU capacity with 152 clean-stacking cranes, more than double the next player in terms of crane count, and with a direct rail route to Memphis, the nation's second largest inland port behind Chicago, will offer a fully integrated freight strategy.

The Hampton Roads region is also breaking records for its transportation investments, which are centered around the \$3.8 billion expansion of the Hampton Roads Bridge Tunnel in anticipation of increased traffic to the already booming corridor. The world's logistics patterns are shifting away from the nation's west coast ports, and as the top emerging market, Hampton Roads and the Port of Virginia are poised to take the lead.
