    - Organized a beautification of their memorial site, creating flower arrangements for headstones and helping to beautify the memorial area by pulling weeds, picking up trash, and cleaning off headstones.
- **Provided items needed for The Virginia Home**
  - Richmond associates also purchased various supplies for residents' daily needs, such as toiletries, sun protection, items to decorate their rooms, arts and crafts supplies, and gift cards for community outings.
  - Purchased prizes to award the residents at their weekly arcade games.
  - Hosted a book drive to fill their refreshed library
