PROJECT OVERVIEW

The YMCA of Virginia's Blue Ridge expanded its regional footprint to Roanoke County and selected the redeveloping Tanglewood Mall for its newest location after an opportunistic site search. Located minutes from Downtown Roanoke, the new space features eight designated pickleball courts, a state-of-the-art wellness center, a hot yoga studio, saunas, two group exercise studios, a children's area, and additional programming space. The new facility opened in December of 2024, less than six months after lease execution.
